

We hold confidential meetings each week for young men and women struggling with the following:

- Drug/alcohol abuse or addiction
- Self-injury
- Eating disorders
- Social anxiety issues
- Depression
- Suicidal thoughts

Meetings are facilitated by an experienced adult; many are also recovering addicts themselves that are especially helpful with the groups.

Always remember and never forget...

On November 17th, 2005, at the age of 18, T.J. Whitehead took his own life after battling drug and alcohol addiction for the majority of his adolescent life. T.J. was a 2005 graduate of Centerville High School. He was a young man who would have liked to have found a place where he could share his story of addiction with those his own age – people who would understand how he was feeling. Unfortunately, he never found that place in the Dayton area.
